### SPRING CURRICULUM

The following are topics of curriculum that may emerge this month: Spiders, Snails, Caterpillars, Butterflies, and Silkworms and other insects. We will continue to talk about spring and animals that hatch from eggs. All classes will be able to observe the incubation of chicken eggs. The incubator is set up in the office and the eggs are expected to hatch by mid-April. Preschoolers will also be observing the life cycle of butterflies (aoina from caterpillars, to chrysalides, to butterflies) in their classroom. We hope to release them in celebration of Earth Day!


